End of School Behavior Reminders

Parents please have a conversation with your student regarding end of the year policies and procedures. Students should be following all school rules and procedures until the end of the year. Students should continue to dress appropriately, leave nuisance items at home (toys, stuffed animals, etc.) and refrain from horseplay and disruptions on campus. Students may receive consequences for inappropriate conduct or behavior until the end of the year.

After School Activities, Tutoring, and Late Bus Transportation

All after school activities and tutoring have concluded for the year and there will be no late bus transportation. All students are expected to promptly exit campus to the bus area, walk/ride home, or wait for parent pick-up at the front of the school.

Last Day of School- May 25th

Our last day of school will be a half day. The first bell will ring at 7:55 am and students will be dismissed at 11:40 am. You may view the adjusted bell schedule [here](#). Breakfast will be served before school, but lunch will *not* be served at the end of the school day. Transportation will still be provided for morning and afternoon routes.

Chromebook Collection

Canarelli will be collecting all student Chromebooks prior to the close of the school year through Science classes. Students and parents/guardians will need to prepare devices according to the expectations outlined in the [Chromebook Cleaning Tutorial](#) provided by the CMS Tech Hub. All students will bring



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home a Chromebook Collection Form next week, provided by Science teachers, for parents/guardians to complete with their student prior to the designated collection date. The collection dates are as follows:

- 8th Grade Collection: Friday, May 20
- 7th Grade Collection: Monday, May 23
- 6th Grade Collection: Tuesday, May 24

If your child missed the designated return date, they will be able to return their device on the next school day. If students are attending Summer Acceleration this summer, they will use a class issued device.

Library Books are Due

As we wrap up the school year, please help your student be sure that all library books and/or textbooks are returned and fines are paid. All library books were due by May 11, 2022. Your student can now easily check his or her account by starting at [Clever](#) and then selecting Follett Destiny Discover from the “Single Sign-On Apps” section. Once your student is logged into Destiny Discover, he/she can select “My Stuff” from the top of the page and then “Checkouts” to see what books are currently checked out. To check for fines on his/her account, select “My Stuff” and then “Fines.” While you can return books or pay fines from other schools here at Canarelli, the librarian from the other school is the only person who can actually remove the book or fine from the account.
