What is Temporary Distance Education?

During the 2021-2022 school year, if a student is unable to attend in-person instruction because of isolation or quarantine related to Covid-19, school staff will assign the student to the Temporary Distance Learning Group. With this status, students will receive instruction at home due to isolation or quarantine via Canvas. Students are only assigned to temporary distance learning by CCSD Health Services Department. This does not apply for regular daily absences and/or illness.

Virtual Attendance During Temporary Distance Education

Students can earn Distance Learning Participation (DLP) attendance and be marked present for class by completing *any* of the following for each class:

- Makes progress in their classwork and submits assignments to the teacher through Canvas
- Participates in real-time class sessions (e.g., attends live Google Meet when applicable)
- Two-way communication between student and the teacher about the lesson or educational progress

If a student is absent during distance learning, they will be marked Distance Learning Non-Participation (DNP) for attendance. Parents should submit a note to excuse the absence by visiting the [Canarelli Middle School 'Submit an Absence Note' form](#).

Daily Participation

Students assigned to Temporary Distance Education are expected to make progress for *each* class period of the school day. We recommend you follow the [Canarelli Bell Schedule](#) listed on our website while working from home. Students should check for Canvas updates and teacher instructions regarding tasks during the temporary distance education placement. In some cases, teachers may offer a Google Meet for virtual students.

Virtual Student Expectations

- Be ready to participate with school appropriate attire
- Maintain a calendar and set alarms to be on time

Show Respect

- Be respectful to staff, self, others, and school property
- Follow all CMS rules and guidelines
- Use school appropriate language
- Be empathetic and support other learners
