



Grading Reform: Reassessment

After a student receives a score on an assessment:

They will be given additional opportunities for learning and practice on critical standards, if needed.



 After reteaching and new learning, students can redo an assessment to demonstrate their new learning.

Grades will only show most recent levels of learning, not an average of an old score with a new score.



Why change?

Some students take more time to learn than others. Not giving them a chance to reassess signals that what they're learning isn't important, and we're not concerned if they actually learn it or not.

What to expect?

More timely communication about whether or not your child needs additional learning or practice. Grades that are more accurate because they show what your child knows when they know it.
